Students can only apply 1 independent study course (HLTH 397, 399, 497, or 499) to the joint major requirements.</li><li>• The Department of Economics will accept one independent study course (ECON 397, ECON 496R, or ECON 496RW) toward the elective requirement for the ECON-HH joint major as long as it is a relevant topic.</li></ul>
