He later served as a strategic counsel to the Minister of Defense between 1999 and 2002. Ambassador Régibeau served as Deputy Commissioner during Belgium's presidency of the European Union in 2010. His ambassadorial responsibilities expanded in 2016 when he represented Belgium in the Russian Federation, Armenia, Belarus, and Uzbekistan. Ambassador Régibeau has also been a recognized scholar with an adjunct professor appointment at the University of Liège. His pivotal academic contributions include "La doctrine nucléaire française et sa dimension européenne" and delving into global issues with "Les causes profondes du 11 septembre".
